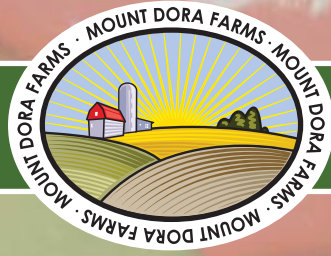

Established in 1986, Mount Dora Farms is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Seaboard Corporation, a diversified international agribusiness and transportation company with annual sales of over \$4.0 billion.



Product Specifications

Our peppers are sourced and processed by our wholly-owned Honduran subsidiary, Mount Dora Farms of Honduras. With annual capacity of over fifteen million pounds, Mount Dora's processing plant in Comayagua, Honduras can provide a variety of jalapeño peppers, both green and red. If you require specifications that differ from the list below, we can be quite flexible. We often provide sizes other than standard ones. Further, we can provide peppers that are diced as well as slices, strips and cores. We can also stuff peppers with other products such as olives.

Mount Dora Farms works with a dedicated group of more than seventy farmers located throughout Honduras to provide the highest quality raw pepper. Mount Dora provides most of these reliable farmers with seedlings from our own greenhouses so we can better control and influence the quality and timing of harvesting. Mount Dora's staff provides comprehensive and integrated support to these farmers. The result is a pepper that is consistently uniform in size and texture and meets our highest quality standards.

Located in the central part of the country, the Comayagua, Honduras plant is a state-of-the-art facility. The processing complex receives raw jalapeños peppers throughout the year. After sorting, grading, cleaning and testing, the peppers are processed into a variety of products of different sizes. After packaging, the processed peppers are ready for export to the United States, Europe and elsewhere.





Quality and Safety

Mount Dora Farms provides each customer with a high level of attention, constant communication, expert knowledge and the drive to provide service that is unsurpassed. These characteristics define our quest for quality. We focus on each customer individually and strive to meet all of your jalapeño pepper needs.

At Mount Dora Farms, we're not happy until we're sure our customers are receiving the freshest and safest processed peppers on the market. To make sure we're getting this done, we launched a HACCP (Hazard Analysis/Critical Control Points) program to go along with the up-to-date Good Agricultural Practices (GAPs) and Good Manufacturing Practices (GMPs) we use every day.

Our HACCP program is based on the FDA Guide to Minimize Microbial Food Safety Hazards for Fresh Fruits and Vegetables, and the IFPA and WGA Voluntary Food Safety Guidelines for Fresh Produce. An HACCP team has identified the critical points in our operation. To assure the correct implementation of the HACCP program, we developed an audit system that is carried out by our in-house Quality Assurance team that enables Mount Dora Farms food safety program to meet the requirements of the US Department of Agriculture Quality Through Verification program.

Mount Dora Farms was recently certified as C-TPAT compliant by U.S. Customs and Border Protection. Further, in September, 2009, our entire Comayagua, Honduras facility achieved ISO 9001 certification.

Our processed jalapeños, both green and red, can be packed in plastic pails or in sealed bags which are placed in reusable plastic crates. All varieties are set in a brine preservative. With on-site warehousing and container loading facilities, we are able to ship our tasty processed peppers throughout the world.
